



Job Announcement 2023-2024: **Math & Science Instructional & Induction Coach** **at Gateway Middle School**

Gateway Middle School is committed to helping each student – regardless of learning style or previous academic achievement – learn the skills, habits and knowledge necessary for success in college and beyond.

Coaching at GMS is a form of professional development where the coach and teacher engage in reflection and learning for the purpose of shifting beliefs, ways of being and instructional practices. As a result, equity and access for students is improved, and positive changes in student outcomes are influenced. This is a full-time position with a start date of July 1st, 2023 (or sooner, depending on onboarding needs).

Key Characteristics of Gateway Middle School:

- A small school where all students are known well and supported to achieve at high levels
- A diverse student body that is supported to be active partners in their education
- A strong commitment to and respect for diversity and difference
- An emphasis on four core values and restorative practices to develop positive relationships and community
- A staff who believes that all students learn differently and who vary their approaches to meet individuals' needs
- A staff who values and embodies collaboration and collective responsibility
- A supportive adult community characterized by continuous learning, reflection and collaboration--particularly in support of anti-racist and pro-Black, inclusive, and equity-focused practices.

Gateway's Approach to Math & Science:

- In math, focus is on CCSS which includes procedural fluency, conceptual understanding and application of math concepts through use of instructional and math language routines.
- In Science, focus is on NGSS, which includes the three-dimensions of NGSS: Content, Science & Engineering, Crosscutting Concepts.

Instructional Coach Responsibilities:

- Facilitate ongoing development of common instructional approach and practices within math and science team
- Coach and support teachers in math and science instruction, through coaching cycles and co-planning
- Coach and support teachers who are enrolled in Gateway Public School's Induction Program
- Collaborate with instructional leaders and coaches to plan and facilitate professional development
- Support math and science teachers to internalize the curriculum, plan common assessments and curriculum, analyze student learning, and differentiate instruction
- Collaborates with our Director of Inclusive Learning and/or Assistant Principal to create assessment schedules for the school as needed
- Support and champion the implementation of Illustrative Mathematics Curriculum
- Support with/coordinate math intervention and help proctor assessments
- Perform other related duties as needed and assigned, such as lunch supervision, etc.

Qualifications:

- Commitment to Gateway's mission is essential, including a desire to work with a diverse student body
- High expectations for your own work, as well as that of students
- Strong desire to work collaboratively with colleagues, parents and students
- Committed to building a strong culture of coaching at GMS grounded in anti-racist practices, culturally responsive teaching and transformational coaching
- Current California credential required -- Multiple Subjects or Single Subject Math or Science Credential
- Familiarity with EDTPA and CSTP frameworks
- Able to use multiple data points to inform instructional and coaching practices
- Minimum of five years experience teaching secondary math or science
- Minimum of three years of teacher leadership and coaching experience strongly preferred
- Bilingual and BIPOC candidates are strongly encouraged to apply
- You are dedicated to being anti-racist and pro-Black

2. Three letters of recommendation OR three professional references (name, relationships, phone/email)
3. Proof of a CA teaching credential or information indicating your eligibility to receive one.
